

JFK COVID Decision-Making Metrics for Building/Class Closure and Required Face Coverings

Due to situations within a particular classroom/homeroom, JFK itself, or even Scott County, there may be times when more mitigation strategies are needed. Below are some of the metrics that will be used. Please note that while we will try to adhere to these metrics, they are subject to change or may be superseded by other factors.



--Scott County 14 day positivity rate at 15% or above

AND

--Building absenteeism at 10% or above in relation to actual illness (not including quarantining persons)

--Must be approved by the Iowa Department of Education

Close the whole building for two weeks and do 100% remote learning for everyone



--Building absenteeism at 25% or above including quarantining persons

Close the whole building for one week and do 100% remote learning for everyone



--30% or more class absent due to COVID or its symptoms (not including quarantining persons)

OR

--50% or more class absent due to health/safety related reasons

Close a classroom /homeroom for one week and do 100% remote learning for everyone in the classroom /homeroom



Face coverings worn by everyone in building at all times regardless of social distancing

Risk of Transmission at School – CDC

> 200 cases per 100,000 in last 14 days in county

AND

> 10% 14 day county positivity rate

AND 2 of following 3

> 10% change in new cases per 100,000 in last 14 days in county

> 90% hospital beds occupied

> 15% hospital beds used by COVID patients

Worn for at least 1 week

OR

JFK Factors Only

15% or more building absenteeism due to health/safety reasons, including quarantining persons

Worn until after the 2nd consecutive day during which the absenteeism rate is below the threshold



Face coverings worn by everyone in classroom /homeroom at all times regardless of social distancing

JFK Classroom

4 or more students absent due to health/safety reasons

Worn until after the 2nd consecutive day during which the absenteeism rate is below the threshold
